I wish to thank you for your kind letter of the 17th November and I hold it an honour to be able to serve my Country in this way.

Re your query of how I met Mr. Sanders. This was done through a Herr M. Grapengeisser, Group Leader of the Auckland Division of the New Zealand Nazi League, of which I am a member. Mr. Sanders has seven Agents operating in New Zealand.

The Chief Centre for the German Secret Service in Holland has been changed from Miss Nora Newman to the firm of Stephan Al. Binting, 23, Stadhoudersplein, Den Haag, while a third Agency under Mr. Hans Friedrich Sutor, Gevers Deynootweg 67, Scheveningen, Holland, has been formed.

I shall in all probability be leaving for Berlin within a month to attend a Meeting of the Gestapo for the purpose of discussing the development of the Service in Australia, New Zealand and the Pacific Islands.

To conclude I wish to add that if any fresh developments occur I shall inform you at once.
